AN ACT to Enable the Town of Upton to Produce and Distribute Electricity within Its Territorial Limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Authority to produce and distribute electricity. The town of Upton is hereby empowered and authorized to acquire, own, maintain, and operate a plant or plants, with necessary equipment and transmission lines, to enable it to produce and distribute electricity for street lighting or other public purposes, and for domestic and industrial uses; provided however that such operation and distribution shall be conducted without financial profit and be confined to the territorial limits of said town.

Sec. 2. Purchase of property. Said town of Upton may acquire by lease or purchase the plant, equipment, transmission lines, good will and franchise of any person, firm or corporation now operating in said town as a public utility producing and distributing electricity.
