STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Enable Cities, Towns, and Organized Plantations to Produce and Distribute Electricity Within Their Territorial Limits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Municipal production and distribution of electricity. Any city, town, or organized plantation may establish, maintain and operate a plant or plants, with necessary equipment and transmission lines, for the production and distribution of electricity for street lighting or other public purposes, and for domestic and industrial uses, provided however that such operation and distribution shall be conducted without financial profit and be confined to the territorial limits of such municipality.
