IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Harbor Masters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 186, amended. Section 186 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

‘Whoever neglects or refuses to obey the orders of such harbor master, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by a fine of not more than \$50, or by both such fine and imprisonment.’
