AN ACT Relating to Registers of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 44, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 44 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'They may make ~~abstracts and~~ copies from the records and furnish the same to persons calling for them and may charge a reasonable fee for such service, but shall not **make abstracts of, or** give an opinion upon the title to real estate. Fees charged by them for ~~abstracts and~~ copies shall be retained by them and not paid to the county.'
