AN ACT Relating to Clerk Hire in the Office of Register of Deeds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 46, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 46 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘Androscoggin county: for clerks in the office of register of deeds, ~~eighteen hundred dollars~~ \$2800; for clerks in the office of register of probate, \$1200; for clerks in the office of clerk of courts, \$2000; for clerks in the office of sheriff, \$600.’
