**AN ACT Relating to the Salaries of County Attorney and Assistant
County Attorney for Androscoggin County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 93, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 93 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 24. Assistant county attorney for Androscoggin county; duties; salary; term of office. The county attorney of the county of Androscoggin may appoint an assistant, to be approved by a justice of the superior court resident in said county or by the chief justice of the supreme judicial court. Said assistant shall take the oath prescribed for county attorneys, and assist the county attorney in the ordinary duties of his office, in the drawing of indictments, in the hearing of complaints before the grand jury, and in the preparation and trial of criminal causes. He shall, when directed by the county attorney, act as counsel for the state in the trial of complaints, before judges of municipal courts and trial justices. Said assistant county attorney shall receive an annual salary of ~~one thousand dollars~~ \$1600 payable from the state treasury in monthly payments on the last day of each month. The assistant county attorney shall hold his office during the term of the county attorney by whom he was appointed, subject to removal at any time by the chief justice of the supreme judicial court.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 125, § 38, amended. Those parts of section 38 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as apply to Androscoggin county, in the 4th line thereof, and in the last paragraph thereof, are hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Androscoggin, ~~eighteen hundred dollars~~, **\$2500,**’

‘The assistant county attorney for the county of Androscoggin, ~~one thousand dollars~~ **\$1600.**’
