AN ACT Relating to Exemptions of Household Furniture.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IV, amended. Paragraph IV of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'IV. The household furniture excluding radios of each person, not exceeding ~~five hundred dollars~~ \$750 to any one household, his wearing apparel, farming utensils, mechanics' tools necessary for his business, and musical instruments excluding radios not exceeding in value \$50 to one household.'
