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**AN ACT Relating to Suspension of Licenses of Malt Beverages.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1937, c. 237, § 15, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 15 of chapter 237 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**‘The liquor commission shall not summarily suspend a license and order a license to be surrendered to it, unless it has reason to believe that the holder thereof is an improper person to have a license.’**
