AN ACT Relating to Roadside Improvement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L., 1933, c. 248, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 1. Construction and maintenance. The state highway commission may, ~~subject to the consent of abutting land owners, cause or allow~~ grasses, shrubs, vines and trees to be planted and maintained in so far as it appears advisable, perform roadside improvement and maintenance along state and state aid highways, to be paid for as part of the cost of construction and maintenance of highways; ~~this cost not exceed \$1500 per year.'~~

Sec. 2. P. L., 1933, c. 248, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 248 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Contracts. The state highway commission may enter into agreements with individuals, ~~or organizations,~~ cities and towns ~~who wish to plant grasses, vines, trees or flowers; or to make gifts or appropriations to carry out the provisions of this act to allow their participation~~

in the expense of roadside improvement and maintenance performed under the supervision of the state highway commission.'
