STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Pauper Settlement of Recipients of Public Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Certain recipients of public assistance, not to be pauperized. No person receiving public assistance in the form of old age assistance, aid to dependent children, aid to the blind, or world war relief shall be deemed a pauper nor shall the receipt of supplementary assistance in such cases, provided from public funds of any nature, pauperize the recipient thereof. The settlement status of such recipients shall not change during the period in which they are receiving public assistance of the nature above mentioned.
