AN ACT Relating to Sentences in the Appellate Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 144, § 19, amended. Section 19 of chapter 114 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

‘or if such appellant fails to appear for trial at the appellate court, and his bail has been declared forfeited, the judgment of the court below, in the discretion of the justice of such appellate court, may be affirmed with additional costs.’
