STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Wholesale Licenses for Malt Beverages.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933, as amended by chapter 159 of the public laws of 1935 and by section 2 of chapter 235 of the public laws of 1937, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 8. License for wholesalers. Licenses for sale and distribution of malt liquors at wholesale under such regulations as the state liquor commission may prescribe may be issued by the commission upon an application in such form as may be prescribed by said commission upon payment of an annual fee of \$300 for the principal place of business, and \$300 for each additional warehouse maintained by such wholesale licensee.

Such wholesalers' licenses may be transferable as to premises in the town originally specified or to premises in another town.

A manufacturer's license issued under the preceding section shall include the right to such licensee to sell and distribute malt liquors at wholesale without the payment of any additional fee. The result of votes cast under the provisions of section 17 of chapter 177 of the public laws of 1939 shall not have any effect upon the granting of such wholesalers licenses in any city, town or plantation.'
