## STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

#### AN ACT to Provide for the Construction, Improvement and Equipment of State Buildings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Construction, improvement and equipment of state buildings. As and when funds therefor can be made available the governor and council are hereby empowered and directed to contract for the construction and equipment of such new buildings and for the improvement and equipment of such existing buildings or property in the following state institutions as they may deem necessary, but with the limitation of amounts to be expended upon each, except as hereinafter provided as follows: Augusta State Hospital:

Buildings for patients and other institutional buildings,	
together with equipment for same	\$692,000.00
Bangor State Hospital:	
Buildings for patients and other institutional buildings,	
together with equipment for same	400,000.00
Pownal State School:	
Buildings for inmates and other institutional buildings,	
together with equipment for same	750,000.00

Western Maine Sanatorium:	
Employees' building and equipment for same	50,000.00
State School for Boys:	
Dairy barn and equipment \$15,000.00	
Vocational training equipment and athletic	
field	22,000.00
State Reformatory for Women:	
Central heating plant and laundry with equipment for	
same	75,000.00
State School for Girls:	
Alterations in heating plant, with equipment	6,000.00
State Reformatory for Men:	
Vocational training equipment	5,000.00

\$2,000,000.00

Sec. 2. All construction shall be by competitive bids. All construction shall be by competitive bids under such conditions and restrictions as the governor and council may prescribe.

Sec. 3. Changes in limitations. If in the judgment of the governor and council the amounts limited in section I hereof shall be insufficient for the suitable and necessary additions and improvements for any of the above named institutions, they may in their discretion exceed the limitation here-inbefore fixed for that institution, but only by effecting corresponding decrease in the limitation fixed for some other institution or institutions.
