RESOLVE, Authorizing the Purchase of Property for the State.

Certain land to be bought. Resolved: That the sum of \$10,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be expended by the governor and council in buying the Frank E. Mace property, formerly the lots 1, 2, and 3 of the Page field in book 571 page 509, in the Kennebec registry of deeds, located on Grove, Capital, and Jackson streets; on Grove street running from the north line of headquarters lot to Capital street; Capital to Jackson street; south on Jackson street to property owned by Mrs. Beals; thence east to property owned by Pease and Guiles; thence north to an iron pin on the northwest corner of the headquarters lot; thence 88 $\frac{3}{10}$ feet to the Grove street place of beginning, with the buildings thereon, and the governor and council are hereby directed and authorized to purchase such property for the use of the state.
