AN ACT Relating to Sale of Deer Meat.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 95, amended. Section 95 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

'Provided, however, that any proprietor of a sporting camp, having an established business in this state, may serve at his place of business as part of a meal any part of a deer lawfully killed or destroyed; provided, however, that he shall annually procure a license of the commissioner, paying therefor \$5 to serve deer as aforesaid.'
