STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Nonresident Fishing License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R.S., c. 38, § 19, amended. Paragraph 3 of section 19 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Nonresident fishing licenses shall be of 3 classes, a 15 day license to cost \$3.15 \$4.65, effective for 15 days from the date of purchase thereof, and a season license, effective for the entire season, to cost \$5.15 \$7.65, but the amount paid for a 15 day license shall be credited on the purchase of a year license upon an additional payment of \$2.15 \$3.15, also a junior nonresident license, which shall be a season license covering all nonresidents between the ages of 10 and 16 years, to cost \$1.15 \$1.65. Fifteen cents shall be retained by the agent for each license issued.'
