STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relative to Trapping Deer on Mt. Desert Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 9, additional. Section 9 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto at the end thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'For a period of 2 years after the effective date of this act the commissioner may authorize the trapping of deer on Mt. Desert Island in the county of Hancock, for liberation in other parts of the state, under the supervision of the warden service. No state funds shall be used for this purpose.'
