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**AN ACT Relative to Closed Time on Wild Hares and Rabbits.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 71, amended.** The 1st sentence of section 71, of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'There shall be a closed season on wild hares or rabbits from the 1st day of March to the 30th day of the following ~~September~~, **November**, both days inclusive, ~~except in the counties of Franklin and Somerset where there shall be a closed season from the 1st day of April to the 30th day of the following September~~, both days inclusive.'
