AN ACT Relative to Possession of Partridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 38, § 55, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 55, of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows :

‘There shall be a closed season on partridge from November 16th to September 30th of the following year, both days inclusive. **During such closed season it shall be unlawful for any person to hunt or have in possession any partridge or ruffed grouse or part thereof,** and no person, shall, during the open season, have in possession in any 1 day more than 4 partridge, or in any 1 open season for partridge or ruffed grouse more than 25 of the above named birds, nor shall any person at any time buy or sell any partridge or ruffed grouse.’
