STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Fees for Licenses for Hotels, Restaurants and Clubs Which Are Licensed to Sell Malt Liquors to be Consumed on the Premises as well as Vinous and Spirituous Liquors to be Consumed on the Premises.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 13, as amended, further amended. Section 13 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933 as amended by section 3 of chapter 79 of the public laws of 1935, as further amended by chapter 234 of the public laws of 1937, as further amended by chapter 118 of the public laws of 1939, is hereby further amended to read as follows :

“Sec. 13. **Retail License Fees.** The fees for licenses to sell malt liquor to be consumed on the premises for each hotel and or restaurant shall be \$200 per annum, and ~~the fee for licenses for clubs~~ each club shall be \$100 per annum, except that if any hotel, restaurant or club so licensed is also licensed under the provisions of chapter 301 of the public laws of 1933 as amended, to sell vinous and spirituous liquor to be consumed on the premises, then, in lieu of the fees hereinbefore in this section set forth and in addition to the fees payable under the provisions of said chapter 301 as amended, the fees for licenses to sell malt liquor to be consumed on the premises shall be \$50 per annum for each such hotel or restaurant and \$25

per annum for each such club. For other retailers not authorized to sell for consumption on the premises, **the fees for licenses to sell malt liquors shall be \$100 per annum, for each place to which licenses apply."**
