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**AN ACT Relating to Emergency Aid on Hospital Cases.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. L., 1939, c. 256, § 1, amended.** Section 1 of chapter 256 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

**'Provided, however, that applications for aid for hospital cases and for medical care shall be cared for by the department when the city, town or plantation is financially unable to do so without the taking over of the affairs of such city, town or plantation by the municipal finance board when the department finds the necessity for such aid is not due to bad management of municipal affairs.'**
