STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Licenses to Sell Malt Liquors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1933, c. 268, § 13, amended. Section 13 of chapter 268 of the public laws of 1933, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 13. Retail license fees. The fee for licenses for each hotel and restaurant shall be \$200 per annum, and the fee for licenses for clubs shall be \$100 per annum. For other retailers not authorized to sell for consumption on the premises, \$100 per annum, for each place to which licenses apply. For a combination license permitting the right to sell: (1) to be consumed on the premises; and (2) to be consumed elsewhere, \$300 per annum.'
