AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Attorney General.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes, as amended is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 6. The attorney general. The attorney general shall have an office in the state capitol and shall receive an annual salary of ~~four thousand dollars~~ **\$7,000**, in full for all services and in lieu of all fees. He shall receive his actual expenses incurred in the performance of his official duties while away from his home.'
