STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Permitting the Digging of Clams in the York River for Bait Only.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Digging of clams on flats of York river. It shall be lawful to dig clams on any of the flats in the York river in the county of York, provided said clams are not used for any other purposes except as bait for fishing.
