STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Personnel Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. L., 1937, c. 221, § 11, amended. Section 11 of chapter 221 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 11. Positions in the classified service; how filled. Positions in the classified service shall be filled by original appointment, promotion, transfer, reinstatement, or demotion in pursuance of rules and regulations established by the personnel board and administered by the director of personnel. These appointments shall not require confirmation by the governor and council.'
