AN ACT Relating to the Licensing of Steam Engineers and Firemen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 5, § 146, amended. Section 146 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 146. Operators to obtain certificates of competency; application; exemption. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to operate a steam plant consisting of boiler and engine where the services of an engineer or fireman are required, without first obtaining a certification of competency from said examiner; sections 145 to ~~154~~ **153**, inclusive, of this chapter shall not apply to **private** dwelling houses, **or** apartment-houses **of 4 or less apartments**, ~~and buildings~~ where the steam plant is used for heating purposes only.

Any person intending to operate a steam plant except as herein provided shall make application in writing to the city clerk, who will notify him in writing when to appear for examination.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 5, § 154, repealed. Section 154 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
