AN ACT Relating to Fire Protection.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 35, § 55, amended. The 1st sentence of section 55 of chapter 35 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

‘The insurance commissioner may incur such expense as may be necessary to carry out his duties in investigating or causing to be investigated the origin of fires and the inspection of buildings and property, **and in the educating and training of firemen.**’
