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**AN ACT Relating to "Transfer Places"**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 41, amended.** Section 41 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection entitled "Fifth" and to read as follows:

**'Fifth. The state police shall designate some place within the state and close to the border on each highway entering the state as a "transfer place" and permit any nonresident owned vehicle to enter the state and proceed to such transfer place for the sole purpose of transferring property to or receiving property from a resident owned vehicle properly registered under the laws of this state and the federal government without requiring registration of such nonresident vehicle.'**
