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**AN ACT Requiring the Payment of Poll Tax Before Obtaining Hunting  
and Fishing Licenses.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 38, § 41, amended.** Section 41 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new paragraph to be lettered 9 and to read as follows:

‘9. No person required by law to pay a poll tax in this state shall be granted a hunting or a fishing license or a continuation of a fishing and hunting license until he shall present a receipt or a certificate to the effect that he has paid his poll tax in the town where he resided for the year preceding that for which application for such license is made, or written evidence from the taxing authority of that town that he was legally exempted therefrom or that the tax has been abated.’
