STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Publication of Legal Notices, Legal Advertising and Other Matter Required by Law to be Published in a Newspaper.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1939, c. 291, amended. Chapter 291 of the public laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Publication of legal notices; regulated. To be qualified as a medium for the publication of legal notices, legal advertising and other matter required by law to be published in a newspaper, a newspaper, unless otherwise ordered by the court in the proceedings, must be published and printed in whole or in part in this state, or, where the law so requires, in whole or in part in the county where the notice is required to be published; must be printed in the English language; and must be entered as second class postal matter in the United States mails at the post office in the place of such printing and publication or have a weekly circulation of 2000 copies or more, which circulation shall not be necessary to be made through the United States mail; providing that nothing herein contained shall be construed to alter or in any way affect the existing law governing the foreclosure of real estate mortgages, chattel mortgages or any conditional sales contract, by publication.'
