STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Warrants Posted in Wards in Cities and in Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 8, amended. Section 8 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 8. Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7, applicable to cities and towns. Sections 4, 5, 6, and 7 apply to cities and the municipal officers of cities, and the same as to towns, and the selectmen of towns, and when any meeting thus provided for is called in cities, and in towns with more than one voting precinct, it shall be by warrants posted in each ward in cities, and in each voting precinct in towns.'
