AN ACT Relating to Legal Documents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 93, § 31-A, additional. Chapter 93 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 31-A, and to read as follows :

‘Sec. 31-A. Penalty for simulating legal papers. No person shall send, deliver, mail, or in any manner cause to be sent, delivered or mailed to any person, firm or corporation, any paper or document simulating or intended to simulate a summons, complaint, writ or court process of any kind. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.’
