IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Creating a Rule of Evidence in Certain Criminal Prosecutions
Under the Motor Vehicle Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, additional. Chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section, to be numbered 88-B:

'Sec. 88-B. Proof of registration. In prosecutions under sections 86 and 88 of this chapter and under the first offense set out in section 87 hereof, against one in whose name the motor vehicle involved is registered, or against its owner, proof of such registration or ownership is prima facie evidence that such person was the operator.'
