STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Branding of Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Suspension of provisions of P. L., 1939, c. 51. The operation of the provisions of chapter 51 of the public laws of 1939 are hereby suspended until such a time as a federal law relative to the subject matter thereof shall have been enacted. If and when such federal law is enacted the governor shall issue his proclamation to that effect, whereupon said chapter becomes effective.
