STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Permitting the Building of a Fish Pond in Madison.

Fish pond to be built in Madison. Resolved: That Earl Fenlason of North Anson is hereby authorized to build a dam and create a pond on a brook flowing through his land in the town of Madison with the right to flow the land owned by Herbert Barkwell and Clarice Barkwell, provided that he has obtained a contractual right to so do, and be it further

Resolved: That the pond hereby created shall be a private pond, and all fishing rights therein are reserved to the owners of the said property.
