AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Justices upon Retirement.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 125, § 5, amended. Section 5 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'Compensation herein provided shall not be made available to any of said justices who after retirement act as attorney or counselor in any action or legal proceeding in which the state or any subdivision thereof is an adverse party or has any interest adverse to the person or persons in whose behalf said justice acts as attorney or counselor.'
