STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Duties of Superintending School Committees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 44, ¶ V, amended. Paragraph V of section 44 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'V. Exclude, if they deem is expedient, any person not vaccinated, although otherwise entitled to admission, unless a parent or guardian of such person shall present a signed statement that such parent or guardian is opposed to vaccination, in which event such person may only be excluded in the event of an epidemic of smallpox.'
