STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Hit-and-Run Driving.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 87, amended. Section 87 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following paragraph:

'It shall be unlawful for the operator of any motor vehicle to leave the scene of an accident without making himself known, after being involved in an accident where there has been an injury to a person or damage to property.'
