STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to the Construction and Maintenance of Bridges on State and State Aid Highways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. L., 1931, c. 93, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 93 of the public laws of 1931, as amended by chapter 137 of the public laws of 1933, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. I. Bridges to be cared for by the state. The construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of all bridges on state highways, and all approaches thereto, and of all bridges on state aid highways, shall be borne wholly by the state.'

Sec. 2. P. L., 1931, c. 93, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 93 of the public laws of 1931 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Definition of state and state aid highways. For the purposes of this act, state highways and state aid highways are defined to be those highways that have been and may in the future be so designated by the state highway commission, in accordance with section 5 of chapter 28 of the revised statutes and acts additional thereto or amendatory thereof.'
