STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Sunday Hunting in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 44, amended. Section 44 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 44. Sunday closed to hunting of birds and animals. Sunday is a closed season, on which it is not lawful to hunt any wild animals or wild birds of any kind except in unorganized territory.'
