AN ACT Relating to Bicycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Use of bicycles at night. All bicycles when in use at night shall show a white light visible from the front for a distance of 200 feet and a red reflector at least 2½ inches in diameter to be placed on the lower portion of the rear mudguard, and must be equipped with an audible signal.
