STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Town Appropriations for Advertising.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 5, § 82, amended. Section 82 of chapter 5 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 82. Appropriation for advertising. Any city or town may appropriate any sum, not exceeding one mill 2 mills on a dollar, based on the valuation of the preceding year, to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources advantages, and attractions of the state or such city or town.'
