STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Authorizing a State Airplane for Defense Purposes.

State airplane. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the proceeds of the bonds for military defense, an amount sufficient to purchase an airplane, equipped with 2-way radio to be used in the carrying out of the defense commission's duties and to be available for any military necessity.
