STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Injurious Substances not to be Placed on Any Way or Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 16, amended. Section 16 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 16. Injurious substances not to be placed on any way or bridge. No person shall throw or place, or cause to be thrown or placed upon any way or bridge, any tacks, nails, wire, scrap metal, glass, crockery, or other substance injurious to the feet of persons or animals or to tires or wheels of vehicles. No person shall throw or place or cause to be thrown or placed upon any way or bridge, any trash or rubbish. Whoever accidentally, or by reason of an accident, drops from his hand or a vehicle any such substance upon any way or bridge shall forthwith make all reasonable efforts to clear such way or bridge of the same.'
