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**AN ACT Relating to Notification by Dealers to Secretary of State of  
Transfer of Motor Vehicles.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 64, amended.** Section 64 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

**'Sec. 64. Dealers to notify secretary of state of sale or transfer of motor vehicles.** Whenever a manufacturer or dealer sells or exchanges a motor vehicle or trailer, he shall immediately notify the secretary of state that the vehicle has been sold or exchanged, giving **the name of the previous owner if a secondhand car**, a description of the vehicle, name of maker, motor and serial number, and name and address of the vendee.'
