AN ACT Relating to Reserved Number Plates.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 29, § 102, amended. Section 102 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘Sec. 102. Number plates 2 to 7000 reserved. The secretary of state shall reserve until December 1 of each year the same registration number for the succeeding year for persons who shall, previous to the 1st day of December of the current year, pay for the registration of his vehicle for the succeeding year plus a fee of \$1, and otherwise comply with the provisions of the motor vehicle law. If a person wishes to retain his registration number and does not have a car to register on December 1st, he may hold his registration number by depositing with the secretary of state a fee of \$11.

Application for registration numbers as herein provided shall be made on cards provided by the secretary of state.

Such registration numbers from 2 to 7000 for pleasure vehicles as are

not issued as above provided shall be held by the secretary of state until December 1 of the year for which the plates are manufactured, subject to application. They may be issued throughout the year to any applicant upon the payment of the registration fee and a reserved number fee of \$1.

All numbers other than those reserved as herein provided shall be released and issued in rotation after December 1 of the current year, except that a person wishing to select a number out of rotation may do so by paying his registration fee and a reserved number fee of \$1.

The amount received from the fee charged for reserved numbers shall go into the general highway fund of the state.'
