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**AN ACT Relating to Registration of Farmers' Motor Trucks.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 57, amended.** Section 57 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

**'Provided, however, that the registration fee for motor trucks, 2 tons and under, engaged exclusively in the carrying or transportation of the applicant's farm products raised or produced on his farm, and farm supplies, and not engaged in hauling for hire, shall be  $\frac{1}{2}$  the above rates. Special plates bearing the word "farmer" shall be issued to such applicants. The term "farmer" as used in this section means any person engaged in the raising, growing and producing of farm products and who does not engage in the business of buying farm products for resale; and the term "farm products" means any food-crop, cattle, hogs, poultry, dairy products and other agricultural products designed and to be used for food purposes.'**
