AN ACT Relating to Guides for Nonresidents.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 51, amended. Section 51 of chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 51. Kindling of fires by nonresidents, regulated. Nonresidents shall not kindle fires upon any unorganized township, while engaged in camping, fishing or hunting from May 1st to December 1st, without being in charge of a registered guide, except at public camp sites maintained by the forestry department. No guide shall at the same time guide or be employed by more than 5 3 nonresidents in hunting.'
