STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Tax on Potatoes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1937, c. 84, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 84 of the public laws of 1937 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 10. Appropriation of money received. Money received through the provisions of this act by the treasurer of state shall be appropriated and used for the following purposes:

(1) For the collection of the tax provided for by section 3 hereof, and the enforcement of all provisions of this act.

(2) A sum which shall equal 40% of the money collected shall be used and applied to the conduct of research and investigational work relative to the control of diseases of potatoes.

(3) A sum which shall equal 40% of the money collected shall be used and applied for the purpose of conducting research work relative to the manufacture and merchandising of potato by-products.

(4) The remainder, including any unexpended portions of the sums authorized under subparagraphs (2) and (3) hereof, for advertising the better grades of Maine potatoes.'
