STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Patriotic Observances in Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Patriotic observances in schools. All pupils in public schools shall recite the pledge of allegiance to the flag of the United States and render the salute to said flag.
